Outline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Schools from Japan, Korea, Taiwan and Singapore will submit a 1 page manga based on a preliminary round theme, these will be judged, and 33 schools (30 from Japan, 1 from Taiwan, 1 from Korea, 1 from Singapore) will be selected to participate in the final championships.</li> <li>The schools from Korea, Taiwan and Singapore participating in the final (August 4 (Sat) - 5 (Sun)) will create a manga within the time limit based on a theme announced during the first round.</li> </ul>
Application Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students in Japanese high school, the upper years of secondary school, the upper years of special support schools, technical college up to third year, as well as vocational schools where the course terms match those of high schools. As well as students in Korea, Taiwan and Singapore who fit these requirements.</li> <li>Only one team can apply per school and each team should consist of 3-5 students, in addition to one leader responsible for the team (teaching staff).</li> <li>To avoid rivalry within schools, each school can only submit one application.</li> <li>※The host organization will decide upon discussion whether any students who do not fit the above criteria may participate.</li> <li>※If a team does not consist of 3-5 members, it may be disqualified.</li> </ul>

Presentation Method	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The manga should be created through the joint effort of all the students, and submitted on 1 sheet of B4 size paper (257mm x 364mm).</li> <li>Teams are free to choose the color, panel layout, and the tools used to create the works (including digital technology), however please be sure to submit a work with a flat surface.</li> <li>Submissions must be original works, and any additions of photographs or identical copies of materials that would constitute a copyright violation is prohibited.</li> </ul>
Application Method	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please send your entry along with this application form to the address stated below.</li> <li>Please stick a copy of the registration form on the center of the back of your application entry.</li> <li>Postal costs are at the expense of the school, so please be aware that we cannot accept entries that require payment on delivery.</li> </ul>
Application Deadline	<b>11 June 2018 (Monday) ※we should receive your entries by this date</b>
Judging Method	A group of professional manga artists will judge the preliminary rounds, which will be held on (Fri) 22 June, 2018 and will decide the 30 schools advancing into the final round and the 5 reserve schools. (In addition, 1 competing school and 1 reserve school will be chosen from each overseas country). • The results of the preliminary rounds will be distributed online simultaneously, and will be posted on the "Manga Kingdom Tosa Portal Site" on the same day. Conditions for participating in the Final	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The host organization will arrange transport to the site of the event in Kochi Prefecture, as well as accommodation.</li> <li>We ask that those participating in the final (including the leader) pay the participation fee of 30,000 yen per person.</li> <li>Any changes made to the students stated on the application form or increases in student numbers in regards to participation in the final round will not be recognized in principle.</li> <li>A decrease in participating student numbers will only be allowed in the case of sickness, or a similarly unavoidable circumstance. ※If, due to a decrease in student numbers, the participating team fails to fulfill the minimum participatory qualifying criteria of 3 members, their participation will be at the discretion of the host organization.</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please be aware that the copyright of works created during the preliminary round and the final round will belong to the host organization, and the works will not be returned.</li> <li>We will send out "confirmation of intent to participate in the final" forms by fax on (Fri) 22 June to schools that have passed the preliminary round. Please reply as soon as possible after receiving confirmation.</li> <li>The media will be reporting on and filming the final round. We ask for your understanding and cooperation regarding possible reporting and broadcasting, transmission online, and the uploading of coverage onto the homepage etc., as well as its usage in publications released by the competition convention.</li> </ul>
